

Bible Study for August 3-9

You are encouraged to take some time to reflect on the scripture and the questions provided either individually, or with members of your household.

Read: Romans 10:5-15

Notes: A right relationship with God is not something we achieve by heroic efforts. It is a gift received in the proclamation whose content is Jesus Christ. This proclaimed word creates our faith in the Lord Jesus Christ. Hence Christian proclamation is an indispensable component of God's saving actions.

Questions to Ponder:

As a child, what was one goal you worked hard to achieve? Did you have any help along the way?

What is one major way your confession of Christ as Lord has influenced your life?

The central affirmation of the early church was "Jesus is Lord". Everyone else at the time was saying "Caesar is Lord." Who (or what) are some gods that compete with your allegiance to Christ?

What are the stumbling blocks in your walk with God?

Why do you think the message contained in the gospels is called "good news"?

What does the word "evangelism" mean to you? How does verse 14 underscore the importance of evangelism?

How can you bring the good news into the life of another this week?
