Bible Study for May 11 - 17

You are encouraged to take some time to reflect on the scripture and the questions provided either individually, or with members of your household.

Read: 1 Peter 3:13-22

Questions:

Verse 15 encourages us to set apart or honor Christ as Lord. What does this mean to you?

If we see Christ as Lord, how will that affect our fears and hopes?

What reasons does Peter give us for hope in this passage?

For the past 2 months we have been living in unusual times. Would you consider yourself as being in a position of suffering? If so, is this suffering for Christ? How is suffering for Christ the same or different?

When we are in the midst of trials, we may be tempted to feel self-pity or despair. How do these emotions compare to Jesus emotions during his trial and crucifixion?

Being physically isolated makes it difficult to reach out to others and offer hope as Peter encourages us to do. What new ways might you find to offer the hope of Christ to others in these times?
