Bible Study for Easter Sunday April 4, 2021

Read: 1 Corinthians 15:1-11

Notes:

Easter Sunday is the heart of the Christian faith. Without the Easter resurrection there would be no reason to hope, no reason for joy, and no reason to celebrate. In our lesson today we find the core of the Christian faith in Paul's preaching the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. As the crucified and risen Christ appeared to the earliest of his followers, so we experience the presence of the Risen One in the preaching of this faith.

Questions to Ponder:

"If I've told you once, I've told you a thousand times..." What issue caused your parents to say something similar to you? Was there an issue that made you say something similar to your children?

Why do you think Paul is reminding them of the gospel in verses 1-2?

Why stress the appearances of Christ as mentioned in verses 5-8? Does this prove the resurrection? Why or why not?

If you had to explain 4 facts of the gospel to an interested friend, what would you say?

Why does Paul feel he is "the least of the apostles"?
