

Bible Study for November 15-21, 2021

Read: Revelation 1:4b-8

Notes:

At some point in time things come to an end. This year, November 21 marks the end of the church calendar with the celebration of Christ the King Sunday, a day to remind ourselves that at some point in time Christ will return again ushering an new era of God's kingdom. The book of Revelation begins by celebrating the Almighty God, who spans all of time. Similarly, Jesus is celebrated as the firstborn from the dead who rules over the world's rulers. He is the one whose return we eagerly await.

Questions to Ponder:

What kind of books interest you? Mystery? Science Fiction? Technical? Adventure? Poetry? Romantic? What is it you like about them?

The word "Revelation" means "to reveal". What do you think is being revealed in this book?

What do you think is significant about the references to God in verses 4 and 8?

What are the meanings of the titles given to Jesus in verses 5-6?

What 3 things does this tell us Christ does for us?

If asked to share 3 things about Jesus that are especially important to you, what would you say?
