## **Bible Study for December 19, 2021**

Read: Hebrews 10:1-10

## Notes:

The author of Hebrews uses the image of religious sacrifice to convey the significance of Christ's coming. Through obedient acceptance of God's will, Christ allows his own body to become the greatest sacrifice of all, one through which we are made a holy people.

## **Questions to Ponder:**

What repetitious activity do you dislike most: cleaning the bathroom? Mowing the lawn? Driving to and from work? Doing the dishes? Getting out of bed? Why?

What daily rituals do you enjoy the most? Why?

The author of Hebrews suggests that the law is insufficient. Why might the law be insufficient?

Knowing how a shadow is made, how might the law be only a shadow of reality?

Going by these verses, what might one positive function of an annual animal sacrifice?

In what ways does Christ replace the inadequate sacrifices of the law?
