

Bible Study for January 10-16, 2022

Read: 1 Corinthians 12:1-11

Notes:

The Corinthian congregation experienced divisions as people were comparing their spiritual gifts, some thinking themselves to be superior to others. Paul invites the community to trust that God's Holy Spirit has gifted them all for their mission together.

Questions to Ponder:

What was the best gift you ever received or gave? What was the occasion?

How many different service or work situations have you had in your lifetime? Which did you find the most fulfilling?

What would you consider to be spiritual gifts? Are there spiritual gifts other than what we find in verses 7-10? Can you list some?

Of the gifts you have listed, are there any that apply to you? Do you make use of them? Why or why not?

If the church is to be considered "one body", is there any reason to think that some spiritual gifts are in any way better than others? Why or why not?
