Bible Study for February 1-6, 2022

Read: 1 Corinthians 15:1-11

Notes:

Paul delivers in a nutshell the story of the gospel that was passed on to him. In the lineage of the Christian faith, we have been told the good news of God's love from generations of believers before us, and we are to continue to tell this story to the world.

Questions to Ponder:

"If I've told you once, I've told you a thousand times..." Regarding what issue did your parents say something like this to you when you were a child? What issue might you have used a similar line with your own children?

Why do you think Paul reminds the Corinthians of the gospel in verses 1-2?

Why might Paul stress the appearances of Christ in verses 5-8? Does this prove the resurrection? Why or why not?

Note how Paul stresses God's grace in verses 9-11. Why might this be incredibly important to Paul?

How have you seen God's grace working in your own life?

If you were to explain four facts of the gospel to an interested friend, what would you say?
