

Bible Study for March 14-20, 2022

Read: 1 Corinthians 10:1-13

Notes:

Paul uses images from Hebrew Scriptures and prophecy to speak the truth of Jesus Christ: He is our rock, our water, our food, and our drink. Christ is the living sign of God's faithfulness.

Questions to Ponder:

What were some rules in your house as a child? Which ones didn't make sense to you? Why do you think they were enforced?

What do you see as the parallel between Paul's words in verses 2-4, and the sacraments?

Why do you think Paul reminds the Corinthians of the mistakes made by the Israelites so long ago? Wouldn't they be outdated?

List the temptations the ancient Israelites faced according to Paul's description here.

How many of these temptations still exist in our world?

What temptations do you most consistently have to face?

Does verse 13 encourage you or frustrate you? Why?
