

Bible Study for March 21-27, 2022

Read: 2 Corinthians 5:11-21

Notes:

One way to describe the gospel is the promise that in Christ everything is transformed into newness. All mistakes, all deliberate sins, all our old history, is reconciled with Christ's resurrection. This is Paul's strong message to the congregation in the city of Corinth.

Questions to Ponder:

If you were appointed as an ambassador for your country, where would you like to be sent? What might you plan to do there?

What do you consider to be "evangelism"? How do you practice evangelism?

What does Paul mean in verse 13 when he talks about being "out of our mind for the sake of God"? Has this ever happened to you?

What does Paul mean by what he says about Christ and our response to him in verses 15-17?

What does "reconciliation" mean to you? Do you have a story from your life which illustrates this?

What motivates you to share your faith? What hinders you?

Have you ever thought of yourself as "an ambassador for Christ"? Why or why not?
