Read: Romans 5:1-11

Notes:

Paul describes the life of faith with reference to God, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit. Even now, we have peace with God through Jesus, and our hope for the future is grounded in the love of God that we experience through Christ's Holy Spirit.

Questions to Ponder:

What benefits are ours as a result of what is said in verses 1-5?

How are suffering, hope, and God's love interrelated?

How do these verses parallel the Old Testament sacrificial system?

What 3 words best describe your life as a Christian?
