

## **Bible Study for June 20-26, 2022**

**Read:** Galatians 5:13-25

### **Notes:**

For Paul, the freedom Christ gives is not permission to do whatever we want. It is the invitation to be what we could not be otherwise. The power and guidance of Christ's Holy Spirit produce a different kind of life, one marked by the fruit of this Holy Spirit.

### **Questions to Ponder:**

What criteria do you use to pick out fruits and vegetables from the grocery store?

Have you ever seen Christian freedom abused? How?

Since we are not under the law, what is wrong with indulging in our sinful nature once in a while?

What can we do to "crucify the sinful nature" mentioned in verse 24?

Verse 22 gives us a list of "fruits of the Spirit". While there is no Godly law against these, can you give examples of human laws that might interfere with them? How might we handle such situations?
