

Bible Study for June 27 – July 3, 2022

Read: Galatians 6:1-16

Notes:

In the closing notes of his letter to the Galatians, Paul encourages them to live as people made right with God through faith in Jesus Christ. Here Paul offers practical advice about how believers exercise common concern for one another in the family of faith.

Questions to Ponder:

As a child, were you ever caught in the act by your parents for doing something you knew they didn't want you to do? What happened?

Why do you think we would like to boast about our good deeds? Who benefits?

How do verses 1-2 illustrate ways of helping someone keep in step with the Spirit?

How can you restore a brother or sister caught in sin and avoid feeling superior to them?

Have you ever become "weary in doing good" (vs 9)? What brought you to that point? How did you get past it?

How does Paul sum up the motives of the false teachers in verses 12-13? What are his motives as mentioned in verse 11?

In what ways are we tempted to make the gospel message less offensive?

How can you help a friend with a specific burden they have?
