

Bible Study for October 31 – November 6, 2022

Read: Ephesians 1:11-23

Notes:

On the first Sunday of November we celebrate All Saints Day, a day to remember the recently deceased as well as those of all time who have reached their heavenly home.

After giving thanks for the faith of the Ephesians, the writer of this letter prays that they might understand the wisdom, hope, and power of God that is embodied in Jesus Christ.

Questions to Ponder:

At what point in life did you first become immensely aware that people die? Other than a pet, whose death did you first mourn?

How might one know if they are “chosen”? Knowing you are adopted by God, how does that change the way you view your relationship to God?

Why does Paul remember the Ephesians in his prayers?

What does Paul ask for in his prayers for the Ephesians? (vs. 17-19)

How do you picture what heaven is like?
