

## **Bible Study for March 13-19, 2023**

**Read:** Ephesians 5:8-14

### **Notes:**

Similar to the Ephesians, we are confronted every day by people rebelling against God's way. As we struggle against temptations, we can count on Christ's word and Spirit to guide us. For our own well-being, we are encouraged to live in the light of the Lord.

### **Questions to Ponder:**

Have you ever been afraid of the dark? What steps were taken to make the darkness more tolerable?

What does it mean to you to live as "children of the light"? vs 8

What might we use to discern what is pleasing to the Lord, as mentioned in verse 10?

- a) How we feel about something personally?
- b) What our relatives tell us is pleasing to the Lord?
- c) Study of scripture?
- d) Prayer?

In verse 11 we are instructed to expose deeds of darkness. How tempted might you be to expose someone's dark deeds so that you look better by comparison?

Is it possible to transform evil persons into good by exposing them? How might one go about that?
