

Bible Study for Sept 21-27

You are encouraged to take some time to reflect on the scripture and the questions provided either individually, or with members of your household.

Read: Philippians 2:1-13

Notes:

As part of a call for harmony rather than self-seeking, Paul uses a very early Christian hymn that extols the selflessness of Christ in his obedient death on the cross. This selfless perspective is to be the essential perspective we share as the foundation for Christian accord.

Questions to Ponder:

Who in your family hogs the bathroom or tracks in the most mud? How did you deal with it?

Reading between the lines, what do you feel was a problem with the church in Philippi?

What are the four motives listed for living in unity?

How do you see unity related to humility?

What stories of Jesus exemplify his humility to you?

How would things change if verses 3-8 became your mantra for living?
